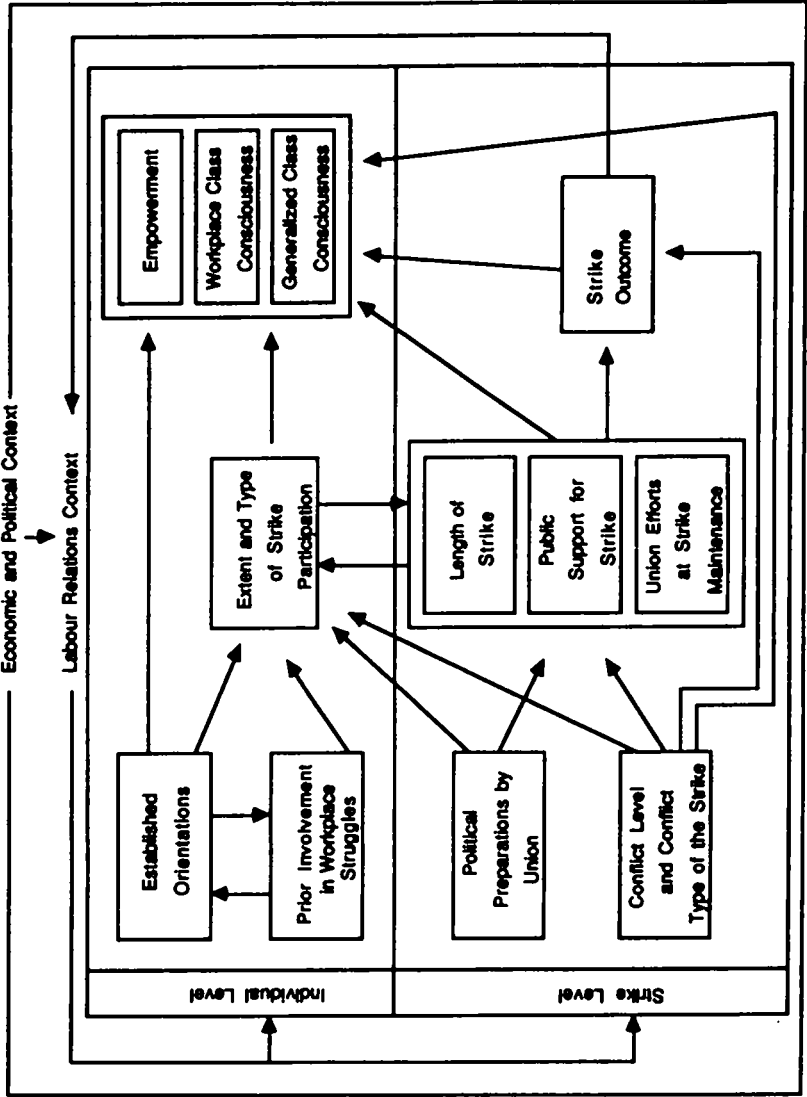


EDITOR'S NOTE / NOTE DE DIRECTEUR

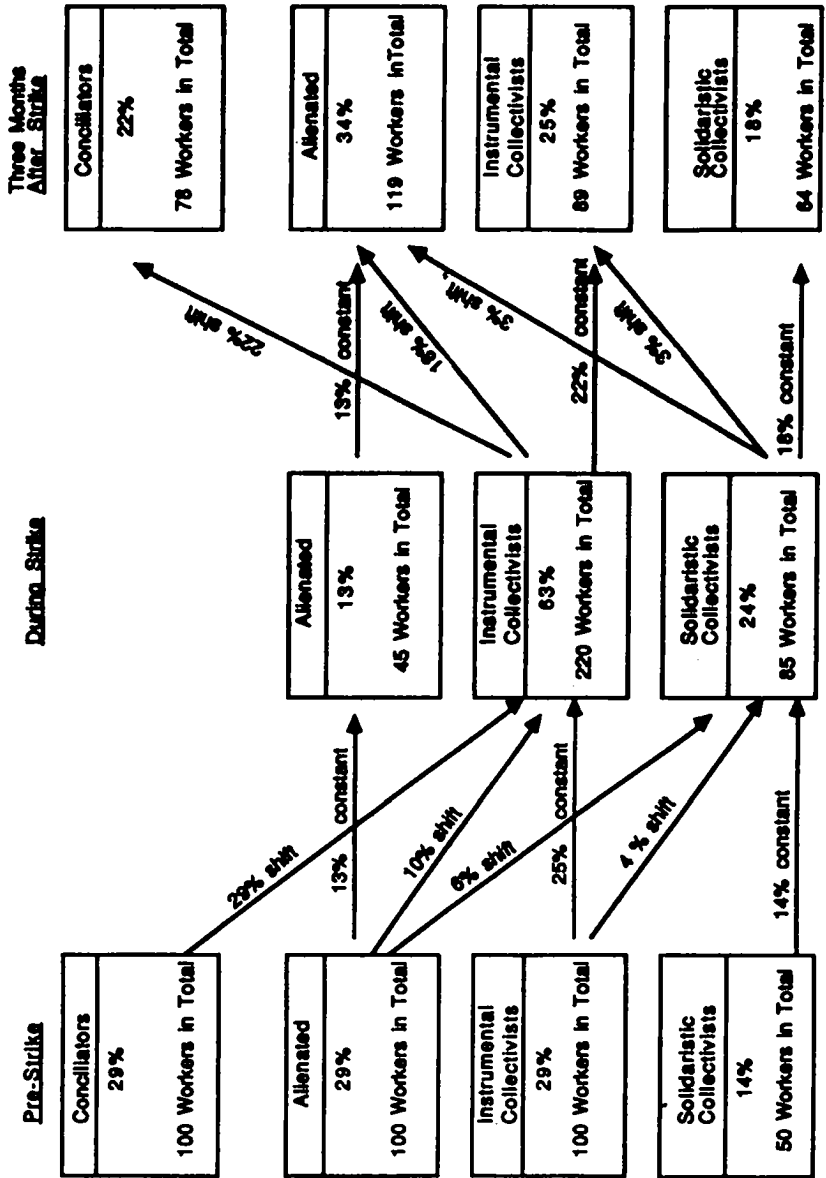
